## *Janae*

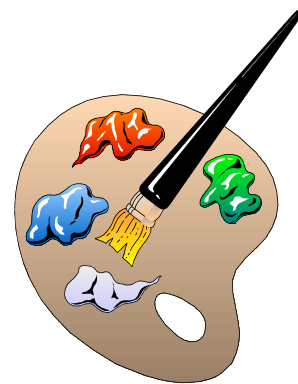
I heard that everyone had a good time at the August gathering/meeting. Wish I could have been there, but we did have a very good time at the wedding with family.

Of course, we all want to come over and see these items in action some day soon!



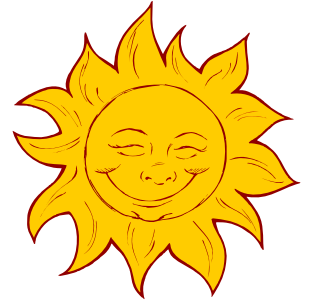
