Good job ladies and thank you to everyone for their service.

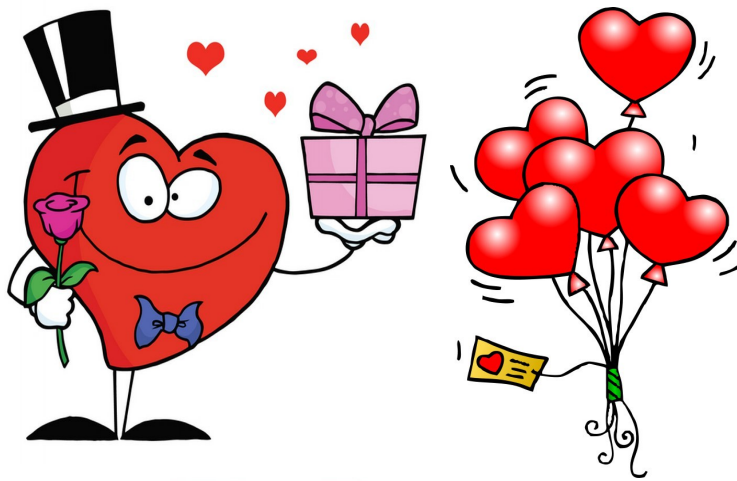

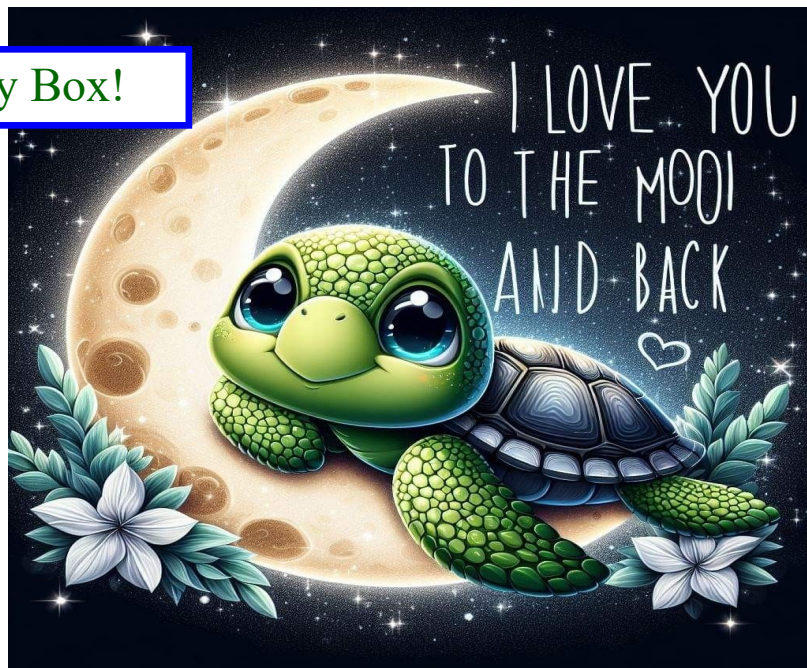
The problem seemed to be that we had become accustomed to a very long lasting fall season.

Frozen Apple Coffee Cake

1/2 cup butter ; softened
1 cup sugar
2 large eggs
1 tsp vanilla
1 cup sour cream
2 cups apples ; chopped
2 cups flour
1 teaspoon baking soda
1 teaspoon baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt

Topping

3 tablespoons flour
3/4 cup Brown sugar
1/2 teaspoon Cinnamon
2 tablespoons butter
1/2 cup Pecans ; chopped

Blend butter, sugar, eggs & vanilla. Add sour cream & apples. Mix dry ingredients together & add to batter. Mix together topping & sprinkle on top of coffee cake.

Makes 2 small coffee cakes (8x8) or 1 large (9x13) – sprayed with Pam. Freeze covered with both saran wrap and aluminum foil.

Remove saran wrap and foil.

Place in cold oven and Bake frozen at 350 degrees for 50-60 minutes for 9x13 and about 10 minutes less for 8x8.
