Meeting adjourned at 10:30. A Crocus flower on a tree branch slice was taught by Betty B.





PAINTING WORKSHEET DRAGONFLY, BEE, LADYBUGS & BUTTERFLY WORKSHEET Dragonfly Using handle end of 3/4 flat brain, dor body 2. Using inky Licerice, Paint details with #2 script timer. J. Dot spots on back with Licanice, using handle end of small brush. Butterfly Load #12 flat with Wicker White/Yellow Inly Wicker White with #2 script liner on wings and body Inky Licorice on #2 script Uner for legs & antennae. Load mini scraffy brush with Wicker White-Yellow Ochre. Pounce body. Bee Paint head with Ecorice, using #2 script liner. Paint stripes with into Ecorice, using #2 script liner. Faint wings, using #8-12 flat loaded with Wicker White, Sidestroke into a little Licorice. Paint ell antennue with Licorice, using #2 script liner. (a) Variation: Stroke body with flu-brush instead of acroffy brush
