Bonnie will lead us in our painting project at the Aug meeting; we will be painting on aprons to wear at the bunco party.



### **Rhubarb Dump Cake**

9x13 Cake Pan

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Lighty spray baking dish with cooking spray(Pam)

### **Ingredients:**

- 4 cups diced Rhubarb
- 3 Ounce box of strawberry jello (day)
- 1 1/2 cup water
- 1 box of Yellow Cake Mix (dry)
- 1/2 cup butter or Margarine

Arrange Rhubarb on the button of the pan. Sprinkle Sugar over Rhubarb, Sprinkle dry Jello over Sugar, Poor water over all of the above. Sprinkle Yellow Cake Mix over all then pour melted butter over the cake mix. Do not stir or mix together, just layer all.

Bake for 45 Minutes

use a little less water when useing frozen Rhubarb. store in the refrigerator ... very important
