
No April Meeting Minutes



Project main colors: Santa Red, Lamp Black, Burlap, Burnt Sienna, Burnt Umber, French Grey Blue, Graphite, Metallic Silver, Hot Shot Red or Highlite Red, and Antique Maroon



Recipes for BHADA

Slow Cooker Broccoli Cheese Soup from Dorothy

- >> 1/3 c. butter, sliced
- >> 1-1/2 C chopped yellow onion
- >> 2 cloves garlic, minced
- >> 6 Tbsp. all=purpose flour
- >> salt & freshly ground pepper
- >> 2 (12 oz) cans evaporated milk
- >> 5 C. low-sodium chicken broth
- >> 5 C small diced broccoli florets
- >> 1/8 tsp dried thyme
- >> 1/2 C heavy cream
- >> 12 oz. sharp cheddar cheese, freshly shredded
 9or more to taste)
- >> 2 oz, parmesan cheese, freshly & finely shredded Melt butter in large skillet over med. heat. Add onions and sauté until soft. Add garlic, flour, and season lightly with salt and pepper then cook, stirring constantly, 2 min. While whisking, slowly pour in evaporated milk. Whisk well to smooth.
- >> Cook mixture, stirring constantly until it begins to thicken then pour into a slow cooker along with chicken broth, broccoli and thyme. Cover with lid and cook on low for 5-6 hours.
- >> Turn heat to warm (or off) and stir in heavy cream, then add in shredded cheddar cheese and parmesan cheese and stir to blend.
- Season with salt & pepper to taste. Serve warm.
